If he had said "Fred from Last Chance," I would have known right away.



Fred's family owned the **Last Chance Saloon** and **Hotel** in **Wayne,** south of **Drumheller.** If you don't know it, then chances are, you don't ride a motorcycle.

Fred managed the business and sold it a couple of years ago. The **new owners** are doing a great job, expanding the business and still welcoming the **bike community.**

Back when I was riding with the **Retreads**, we would take over the Last Chance one weekend a year in June and club members from all over **Alberta** would show up. There was food and the Last Chance bar was open, but mostly there were Fred stories. It was a **fitting tribute**.



An oil thread...



We're not looking to start a fight here, but this is about oil.

It's not what brand, so relax. The question of the day is - What's your oil change interval?

Most of us go by the book. The Victory manual says oil change every **5,000 miles**, that's a trip to **Longview** over **8,000 kilometres**.

Again, most err on the side of caution and change at **7,000 kms**, just because it's so easy on a Victory.

Buzz on the forums is that if you use **full synthetic** oil, you can push it to **10,000 kms.**

The above **chart** goes by oil colour, It takes environmental and mechanical conditions into consideration, as well as time.

Oil gets dirtier faster in engines that spend **too much time** in the top and bottom of the tach. **Hot weather** will shorten oil life as well. Dirty oil means engines run **hotter**, **noisier and wear faster**.

Remember, oil changes are cheap; **motors are expensive**.
